

HOME RESCUE

Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program designed to fix code problems and lead hazard issues

OVERVIEW

Homeowners participate in this program to fix code problems and lead hazard issues within their home. Concerns within the home that may be addressed include: roofing, windows, siding, plumbing, electrical, etc.

This is not a home remodeling program.

FUNDING

This home preservation work is provided to you through a variety of Maumee Valley Habitat for Humanity funding sources including federal, state, and local funding, generous donors, and neighborhood community groups.

As a condition of this funding, homeowners are required to sign a 10-year deferred payment loan/mortgage, contingent upon maintaining occupancy and being the owner on record.

REQUIREMENTS 1. Ownership

You must be the owner of record and have lived within the home for a minimum of 3 years.

2. Income

You must meet the gross federal income requirements as determined by HUD. Please see chart to the right.
