

"ME AND MY BUDDY" BENCH

Materials Needed:

- 1. 2in. x 8in. x 6ft. (Qty: 1)
- 2. 2in. x 4in. x 8ft. (Qty: 1)
- 3. 2 1/2in. Phillips wood screws (Qty: 24)
- 4. Sandpaper
- 5. Paint or Stain
- 6. Paintbrush
- 7. Foot Pad Nail Protectors (Qty: 4)

Tools Needed:

- 1. Circular Saw
- 2. Screw Driver
- 3. Drill and bit
- 4. Measuring Tape
- 5. Sandpaper
- 6. Hammer
- 7. Safety glasses

Grade Level: 4-12

Project Time: 3-4 hours



If you are building the bench to be 4 foot (or longer), we recommend adding the diagonal support as above.

Instructions:

- 1. Gather materials
- 2. Have adult cut wood to appropriate lengths as shown on next page
- 3. Sand all pieces
- 4. Take all cut pieces of 2" x 4" to assembly frame for legs (see Diagram A)
- 5. Glue all pieces together with wood glue and let dry for approx. 10 minutes (see Diagram B)
- 6. Drill 2 holes in each corner of the frame, and connect wood pieces together with screws (see Diagram C)
- 7. Lay out the two 2" x 8" x 36" boards next to each other on a flat surface (see Diagram D)
- 8. Place the framed legs on each end of the boards 4"from the edge and 1-1 ½" in from each side (center)
- 9. Drill 4 holes in the top piece of each leg frame and screw legs in place (see Diagram E)
- 10. Paint or stain entire bench (optional)
- 11. Hammer the foot pad nail protectors on the bottom of each leg (see Diagram F)
- 12. Turn bench right side up and "have a seat with a buddy" (see Diagram G)
