

## "HAPPY HERBS" Herb Stone Markers

## **Materials Needed:**

- Smaller, smooth landscaping rocks
- Acrylic paint
- Acrylic paint markers
- Acrylic paint sealer (spray or brush on sealer)
- Safety glasses
- Gloves
- YOUR creativity





Grade Level: K - 12th

Project Time: 1 - 2 hours,

plus drying time

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Cover table with newspaper. Organize your acrylic paint and paintbrushes.
- 2. Paint landscaping rocks with acrylic paint. Let dry overnight.
- 3. Using acrylic paint markers, write the name of your herbs of choice (Ex: mint, thyme, basil, oregano, parsley, sage, rosemary, etc.).
- 4. Using acrylic paint markers or small-tip paintbrush, decorate rocks (flowers, polka dots, stripes, zig zags, etc.). Be creative and take your "thyme"!
- 5. Let dry overnight
- 6. Place herb stone markers in your herb garden and enjoy!
