#### What should I expect?

This event will take place rain or shine.

A program will begin (Saturdays) at 10:00am (Weekday) 1 pm. Please plan to arrive 10/15 minutes prior to check in. A REQUIRED safety meeting will follow directly after. Project assignments will be given day of. Assignments will be determined by the ages of your group as certain projects will be prohibited by youth due to safety concerns.

A snack bag will be provided in the morning. Water bottles will be available throughout the session.

#### What should I wear?

Closed toed, closed back shoes such as boots or tennis shoes are REQUIRED.

Pants and long sleeves are recommended due to the possibility of poison ivy.

If your group or company has matching shirts, please wear them!

### What should I bring?

Your completed Liability Waiver (completed on line, but we will have extra on site if needed). Anyone under the age of 18 must have their liability waiver signed by their parent/guardian.

If you have hand tools/landscaping tools, especially rakes, hand held shovels, hedge shears, loppers, please bring them. We recommend labeling any tools you bring. Personal protective gear. If you have safety glasses and work gloves, please bring them. If not, we will have gear you can use for the day.

#### What shouldn't I bring?

Do not bring valuables. We do not have on-site storage for purses or bags. However, please bring your cell phones as this will help you navigate the neighborhood and we would love to see your pictures too! All work sites are smoke free, alcohol free, and drug free.
