

### "ROCK ON" PROJECT

This project consists of collecting and painting rocks with positive messages and artwork.

#### **Materials Needed:**

- 1. Rocks Size: 5" x 5" 10" x 10" diameter
- 2. Ruler (for measuring rocks)
- 3. Acrylic paint and/or acrylic paint markers
- 4. Variety of Paint brushes (large, medium, small tip)
- 5. Acrylic paint sealer (spray or brush on sealer)
- 6. Painting gloves
- 7. Safety googles
- 8. YOUR creativity

Optional: Q-tips (perfect for polka dots), Toothpicks (for fine point detail), Sponges, Cotton Balls. Take a look around your home for items that can be utilized – be Creative!

### **Grade Level:**

4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

# **Project Time:**

Collecting rocks, 1-2 hours paint time, Recommended drying time





#### Instructions:

- 1. Gather rocks from outside while enjoying the fresh air.
- 2. Wash and dry rocks.
- 3. Prime/paint a base coat with acrylic paint on the top and sides of your rock. Use a solid color of your choosing. Let dry a minimum of two (2) hours.
- Using acrylic paints, or acrylic paint markers, decorate with the images of your choice or write a positive message. (Ex: "Home Sweet Home", "Be Kind").
- 5. Allow rock to dry two (2) hours.
- 6. Put your first name or initials and date on the bottom of the rock.
- 7. Wash your paintbrushes and allow all items to dry overnight.
- 8. Spray or brush on acrylic paint sealer. Allow to dry overnight.
- 9. Clean your workstation and wash all paintbrushes.
- 10. Pat yourself on the back for a job well done and for becoming an Honorary Habitat ROCK STAR.
- 11. Donate decorated rock to Maumee Valley Habitat for Humanity. \*Collection date/location to be determined.
- 12. Pat yourself on the back again because YOUR hard work just made a difference. You truly are a ROCK STAR.
